

Level rates support same level of service

The Energy Efficiency Charge (EEC) that appears on your electric bill each month enables Efficiency Vermont to provide services and products that help you save money. In 2019, Efficiency Vermont's budget will remain the same as the prior year, resulting in flat EEC rates for commercial and industrial customers and a slight decrease in residential EEC rates. The chart to the right shows the new EEC rates for 2019, set by the Public Utility Commission. Take advantage of our energy services by visiting www.energycvermont.com.
