Eligible members to see patronage credits in Sept.

In the coming weeks, VEC will be distributing to members, including commercial and industrial members, a total of \$1.2 million in patronage capital credits. This year's distribution will take the form of a September bill credit for eligible members who paid electric charges in 1997 and/or 2018.
